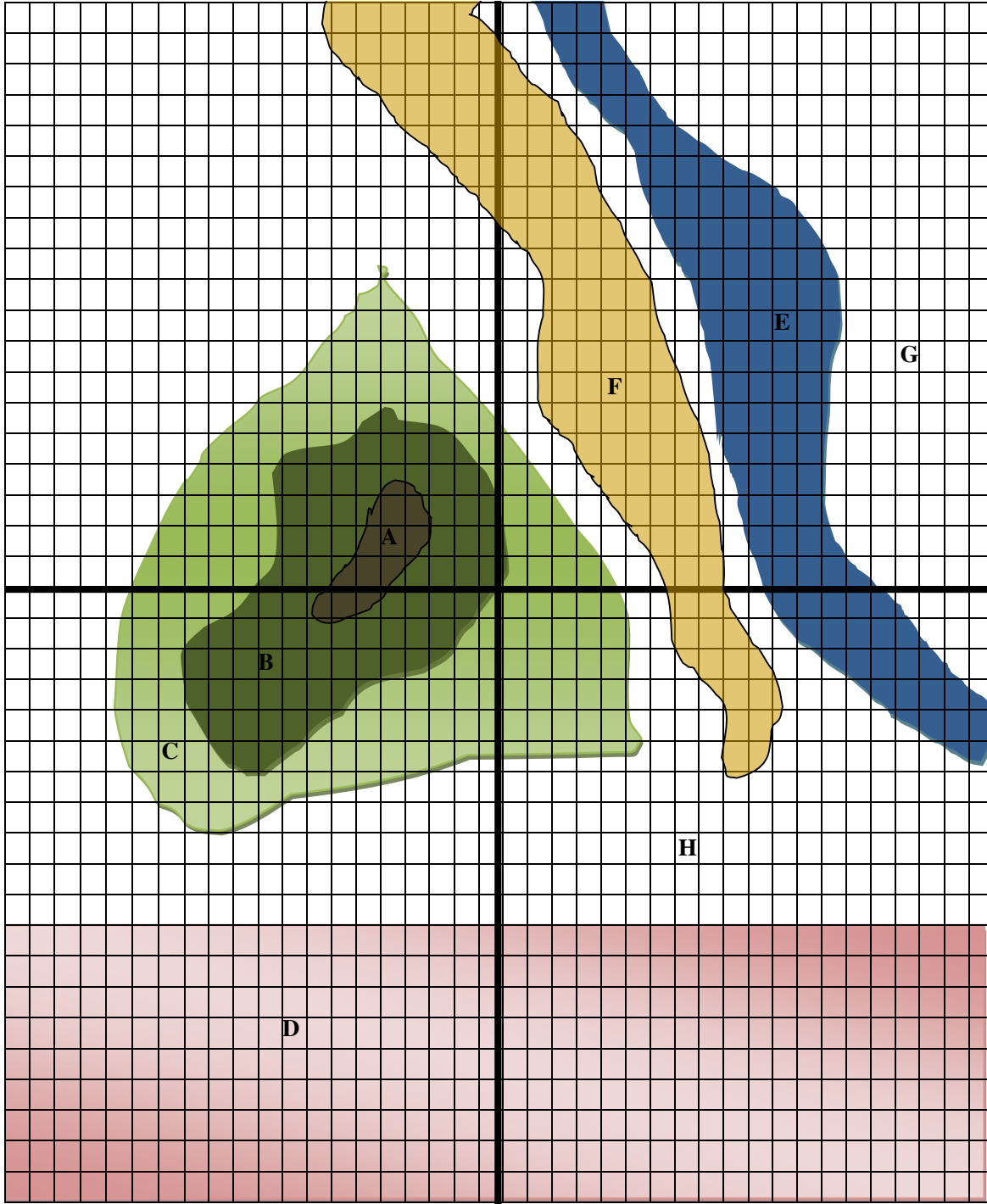


Map of the local woods.



- A** – Top of the hill. Relatively well-forested. Well-drained soils.
- B** – Partway up the hill. Lower elevation than A, but higher than C.
Relatively well-forested and well-drained soil.
- C** – Lowest part of the hill. Lower than A and B, but higher than the other outlying areas.
Same conditions as A, B.
- D** – Deforested area with little to no tree growth. No shade conditions.
- E** – The local river.
- F** – Sandy soil on the south bank of the river. Many trees have been cut in this area.
Relatively well-drained.
- G** – Area northeast of the river. Moist soil with relatively healthy forest cover.
- H** – The remaining area southwest of the river. Well-forested with flat, well-drained soil.
