

2019 Ontario Envirothon Presentation Challenge

Rules & Regulations

Theme: Agroecology

The Presentation Challenge is modeled after the presentation component of an Ontario Envirothon event. In teams of 5, students will research, plan and film a presentation in response to a provided scenario. Each team is eligible to submit 1 video for consideration and videos must be between 12 and 15 minutes in length.

Teams are encouraged to access past Ontario Envirothon study guides and resource materials to prepare their presentation.

The Presentation Challenge winners will be invited to compete in the 2019 Ontario Envirothon Championships.

Rules & Regulations

1. Each team member must be enrolled in grades 9-12 for the entire 2 semester school year
2. Each team will consist of 5 students from the same school, home-school group or local organization
3. Video presentations must be between 12 and 15 minutes in length. Videos exceeding 15 minutes will not be considered
4. Completed videos are to be posted to YouTube, teams must provide Forests Ontario with a link to their video by the submission deadline
5. Videos are to be posted online no later than midnight on March 29th, 2019. Videos submitted after this deadline will not be considered
6. Only 1 video entry will be considered per team
7. All five team members are expected to participate equally in the video
8. Video presentations will be reviewed and scored by a panel of judges
9. The winning team will be notified by April 12th, 2019
